BOWLING ETIQUETTE

Bowls is a sport that encourages social interaction and friendship. Etiquette simply means displaying “good sportsmanship” by having knowledge of what behaviour is acceptable in the game and applying it using common sense and consideration for others.

During The Game

- Be on time and ready for the start of the game.
- Switch off or mute your mobile phone.
- Introduce yourself to all players.
- Keep your mind on the game and follow what is happening at the head. Be ready to play as soon as your turn comes.
- Bowls lifters should be left either under a bowl or on the bank in a safe position.
- Inform your opponent if you need to leave the game. You have up to 10 minutes.
- Do not talk or move around while another bowler is preparing to deliver his bowl.
- Do not carry on a running commentary as each bowl makes its way to the head.
- During the game encourage your team mates and commend good shots.
- Do not criticise bowls either from your team or the opposing team.
- Do not barrack for unlucky results nor misfortune from your opposition’s bowls.
- Stand at least one metre behind your opponent while he has the mat.
- Remember that your opponent has possession of the rink until his bowl comes to rest.
- After delivering your bowls retire to the bank.
- Change of ends should not commence until your opponent’s last bowl has stopped. Walk quickly between ends and within the confines of the rink on which you are playing. Avoid walking through the head. All bowlers should be behind the head when the skip is ready to be bowl.
- Avoid standing on the outside confines of the rink where a player is taking their aiming point, this often results in the peg being obscured.
- After changing ends, stand on the bank unless directing play.
- If an umpire is called, give any assistance required then retire to the bank until the umpire has reached a decision.
- The umpire’s decision is final in all circumstances except those relating to the meaning or interpretation of a law. In that circumstance there is to be the right of appeal to the Controlling Body.
- Bowls should not be moved until the head has been declared.
- After the result has been determined, help clear the head by kicking bowls to the left and behind the mat.
- At game conclusion, show a good spirit, win well and lose well.

RULES FOR CLUB MATCHES

1. **Dress:** **FORMAL** All-white Top, White or Cream Trousers, White Socks, Bowls Shoes. Club Shirt and Pennant trousers may be worn provided they are worn by all team members.
2. **Games:** When arranged, details are to be entered in **Blue Book on Bowls Office Door.** **Details: Names, Date, Time, Event**
3. **Days of Play:**
 - (a) As scheduled in Calendar of Events for 2016
 - (b) Matches not completed on scheduled date are subject to forfeit
 - (c) The Match Committee reserves the right to change the date and time of any event
 - (d) Singles matches must arrange their own marker. Players losing a singles match are requested to be available to mark in subsequent matches
4. **Matches:**

(a) SINGLES:	31 shots up. Four bowls played singly and alternatively
(b) PAIRS:	21 ends. Lead 2 bowls, Skip 2 bowls played singly and alternatively, and then repeated
(c) TRIPLES:	25 ends. Two bowls played singly and alternatively
(d) FOURS:	21 ends. Two bowls played singly and alternatively
5. **Scoring:** PRESIDENT'S CONSISTENCY SINGLES
100 points plus Handicap: Shot bowl 4 points, 2nd shot 3 points, 3rd shot 2 points, 4th shot 1 point, giving 10 points per end.

When the jack is rolled to start each end, and is placed on the line, a washer is to be placed under the jack. Should the jack be moved by any bowl it is to be replaced back on the washer.

Player with highest score retains mat. If the end score is 5-all, the player that had the mat on the previous end retains it.

Handicaps are to be played off fully. eg. Player A -6, Player B -18. Player A starts from -6 and Player B starts from -18. The score card is to show Player A -6, then -5, etc. and Player B -18, then -17, etc. as shots are scored.

- 6. General:** (a) Bowls Discs – worn or faded discs shall be removed. If discs are used all bowls in use must have identical discs on each side
(b) Draws – **a Draw shall not be amended or in any way interfered with by any player**
(c) Trial Ends – two trial ends may be played prior to the commencement of matches using the number of bowls to be used in the event, on each end
(d) Entries – Sheets for nominations for Club and District events will be posted on the notice-board near the Men's Bowls office. Entry fees for events shall be placed in an envelope marked with the players name(s), event and amount. The envelope should be handed to either the Bowls Secretary or the Assistant Bowls Secretary.
- 7. Score Cards:** When a match is completed, the score cards are to be placed in the box provided in the Bowls Office
- 8. Finals:** The Finals of Club Championship Singles, Pairs, Triples and Fours shall be played on the date nominated by the Match Committee. Similarly the Match Committee reserves the right to schedule Finals of other events in a like manner
- 9. Definition of Minor:** A bowler who has not won a Club Singles or Pairs Championship (or better, eg. District Championship) in any Club. A bowler who has won the Minor Singles or Minor Pairs at MIBC cannot enter the same event again.

DUTIES OF THE MARKER

The marker shall:

1. Centre the Jack and place a full length Jack 2 metres from the ditch
2. Ensure that the Jack is a minimum of 21 metres from the mat line after it has been centred
3. Stand at one side of the rink and at least 2 metres to the rear of the Jack
4. Answer any specific question relating to the existing state of the head while the player is in possession of the rink and, when requested, clearly indicate shot if possible
5. Mark all touchers immediately they come to rest and remove marks from non-touchers. With the agreement of both opponents, remove all dead bowls from the green and ditch and mark the position of the Jack in the ditch
6. Not move or cause to be moved either Jack or Bowls until each player has agreed to the number of shots
7. Measure carefully doubtful shots when requested. If the decision is unsatisfactory to players, call for an umpire, whose decision is final
8. Enter the score at each end and intimate to players the state of play of game, When the game is finished, see that the score card is signed by players and disposed of according to the rules of the competition
